The following list will help you complete the application process. Please submit the following items to the Admissions Coordinator prior to scheduling your interview with the Superintendent.

- Application Forms:
 - Family Information
 - Student Information
 - Clergy Recommendation or Parent Statement of Faith
 - Middle School Supplement for students entering grades 6th – 8th
- Application Fee of \$150 per family (non-refundable)
- Immunization Records
- Copy of Birth Certificate
- Report Cards from the previous 2 years (does not apply for JK or Kindergarten)
- Standardized test results from the previous 2 years (3rd Grade and older)

Depending on the grade your student is entering, the following screenings must also be completed prior to your interview.

- Readiness Screening (Gesell) \$100 per student fee applies (JK, Kindergarten, 1st & 2nd Grades)

All new students entering Jr. Kindergarten – 2nd grade are screened to determine the child's developmental age. Minimum developmental ages when school begins are:

<i>Jr. Kindergarten</i>	<i>4.5 years Developmental Age</i>
<i>Kindergarten</i>	<i>5.2 years Developmental Age</i>
<i>First Grade</i>	<i>6.2 years Developmental Age</i>
<i>Second Grade</i>	<i>7.2 years Developmental Age</i>

- Grade Placement Testing

Required for students entering 3rd grade or higher whose standardized test scores and report cards included with the admission application do not consistently affirm grade placement
