We will be having our spelling tests (25 words and fill in the blank paragraph spelling). The pretests (that you can use to study) will be located to the language section of their binder.

We will be starting our Bible Memory this week with Psalm 23: 1-3. The quiz will be next Wednesday (September 10). It will be fill in the blank format.

The students will be having math and spelling homework starting today.

Thursday—Math—5, spelling—separate the spelling words into syllables (25 word list only), Bible memory—study for quiz next Wednesday, study the kinds of sentences

Friday— spelling tests (25 words and paragraph), Bible memory—study for quiz next Wednesday, study the kinds of sentences
